Moratorium on boarding schools, group homes, and any facilities for the care of children with the exemption of daycares.

- Begin:** September 3, 2002
- Extension:** January 6, 2003 (a 90 day moratorium was extended at the 11/18/02 meeting from December 2, 2002)
- Changes:** Removal of adult facilities from moratorium (at the 12/2/02 meeting)
- Extension:** April 6, 2003 (Extension of 90-days at the 1/06/03 meeting)
