

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF
ROWAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR SESSION
JUNE 5, 1972

The Board of Rowan County Commissioners met in a Regular Session in the Community Building, Salisbury, North Carolina at 9:00 a.m. The following members were present: Chairman Eugene McCombs, J. Lewis Sowers, Charlie Walters, and Rufus Honeycutt.

Chairman McCombs called the meeting to order and opened with prayer. Upon a motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Honeycutt, the minutes of the meetings of May 1 and May 22, 23, 24, and 25, 1972, were unanimously approved.

A letter was read from the State Planning Division stating that they have approved Clearinghouse notification no. 72-0497 for the Rowan County Water system, phase I.

A letter was read from Mr. Wade Mobley, Superintendent of Rowan County Schools, requesting that the \$2,364.37, that was made from the sale of old furniture at the Dukeville School, be added to this year's furniture account for the purchase of new furniture. Upon a motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Honeycutt, this request was unanimously approved.

The County manager read a letter from Mr. C. O. Bowers resigning his position as Building Inspector. Mr. Walters moved that this resignation be accepted. Mr. Honeycutt seconded, with unanimous approval.

Upon a motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Honeycutt with unanimous approval, Mr. Charles Glover was appointed to the Water & Sewer Committee, and Mrs. Jane Smith was re-appointed to the Parks & Recreation Commission.

A resolution to grant Salisbury approval to extend the zoning area outside the city limits to two miles was unanimously passed upon a motion by Mr. Honeycutt, seconded by Mr. Walters. (attached)

Upon a motion by Mr. Honeycutt, seconded by Mr. Walters, a resolution to participate in the Federal Rent Supplement program in East Spencer was unanimously approved. (attached)

Upon a motion by Mr. Honeycutt, seconded by Mr. Sowers with unanimous approval, a resolution was passed to classify an unnamed stream on Bringle Ferry Road as a Class A-II stream. (attached)

The following refunds were unanimously approved upon a motion by Mr. Honeycutt, seconded by Mr. Walters:

Carolina Fleets, Inc. - \$16.65
John L. Dietz - \$5.00
Gaston Connell - \$15.00

Mr. Clay Price of the Chamber of Commerce asked Commissioners for their support in conducting a soil survey of Rowan County and publishing a booklet of the findings of this survey. The cost to the County would be \$16,000 a year for five years for a total of \$80,000.

After much discussion, the Commissioners decided to look into this matter further before making a commitment.

Mr. Glenn Trexler, Tax Collector, reported the total collections for the month of May as \$80,161.81.

A resolution to levy a privilege license tax was unanimously approved upon a motion by Mr. Honeycutt, seconded by Mr. Walters. (attached)

The following change orders and final bills for work on the community building were approved upon a motion by Mr. Honeycutt, seconded by Mr. Walters:

Payment of these items leaves a deficit of 43,268.79 which is to be appropriated out of contingencies.

Upon a motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Honeycutt, payment of the following items was approved. Attached.

Chairman McCombs reported that the total interest collected through May 31, 1972 is as follows:

A letter was received from Sheriff Stirewalt and one from Chief Junius Bost thanking the Commissioners for the riot equipment that has been purchased.
