

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF
ROWAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
ADJOURNED MEETING
JULY 20, 1981

The Board of County Commissioners met in Adjourned Session in the Community Building, Salisbury, North Carolina on July 20, 1981 at 9:00 P.M. after an informal briefing on revaluation by W.P. Ferriss. The following people were present: Chairman Eugene McCombs, Commissioners Rufus Honeycutt, Hall Steele, Jim Sides and Jim Cohen.

Chairman McCombs opened the meeting and entertained a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. Jim Sides moved that the Board go into Executive Session. Rufus Honeycutt seconded with unanimous approval.

After a short discussion of the matter, Rufus Honeycutt moved that the Board go back into regular session. Jim Sides seconded with unanimous approval.

Jim Sides moved that Jim Helms be contacted and offered the Building Inspectors position temporarily vacated by Marshal Washam due to an illness. Helms salary would be at the same rate as that presently being paid Washam. Since Washam has forty-four days combined sick and vacation leave, this would cost the County approximately an additional \$2,000. Mr. Sides also stated in his motion that if Helms was not available, for Craige Trexler, Department Head, to find a qualified inspector to temporarily fill this position. Jim Cohen seconded with unanimous approval.

The Board received and accepted the resignation of Carol Morgan, Secretary in the Veterans Service Office effective July 20, 1981. The Manager was told to hire Cindy Tatum on a temporary basis until a replacement could be found through an advertisement in the paper.

The Board learned that there will be a public hearing on the Secondary Road Construction Program on Monday, August 24, 1981 at 7:30 P.M. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
