

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD
OF ROWAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AIRPORT HEIGHT ORDINANCE HEARING

Mr. Johnson continued that an effective date was also needed for acceptance. Commissioner Swaim made a motion to accept the revisions and to adopt the Ordinance effective July 10, 1989. Commissioner Knox seconded with unanimous approval.

There being no other discussion, Commissioner Knox made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and Commissioner Swaim seconded with unanimous approval.
