

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD  
OF ROWAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - AUGUST 16, 1990  
SA9 SITE - JOHN BOLES' PROPERTY

The Rowan County Board of Commissioners held a joint Special Called Meeting with the Iredell County Board of Commissioners on Thursday, August 16, 1990 at 5:00 p.m. on the SA9 site (Jon Boles' Property).

The purpose of the meeting was the presentation of information from the Joint Site Designation Review Committees.

Iredell Board Chairman R. B. Sloan called the (Iredell) meeting to order, and stated the purpose of the meeting.

Rowan Chairman Newton Cohen called the (Rowan) meeting to order, and explained that its purpose was to receive the report from Dr. John Barr and Dr. Pam Sholar, Co-Chairmen of the Committee.

Chairman Sloan (Iredell) entertained a motion to receive the report from the Site Designation Review Committee, and submit it to the Hazardous Waste Management Commission on Friday, August 17th. The Board agreed by consensus.

Chairman Cohen (Rowan) received a motion by Commissioner DeMarcus to receive the report by the Site Designation Review Committee, and submit it to the Hazardous Waste Management Commission on Friday, August 17th. Commissioner Knox seconded, with unanimous approval.

At this time, Chairman Sloan (Iredell) noted that, even without consideration to population, industry and other important factors, the report is adequate and should immediately disqualify the SA9 site from further consideration.

Rowan Chairman Cohen explained, for the benefit of the audience, that parts of the report were received yesterday, and the remainder received today. He believes the issue of four-lane highway criteria is the "trump card" to victory.

Due to previous commitments, Chairman Sloan asked permission of the Iredell Board, to be excused from the meeting. The Board agreed by consensus.

Rowan County Manager Tim Russell then distributed prepared Press Releases to members of the audience, as attached to these Minutes. Co-Chairmen Dr. John Barr and Dr. Pam Sholar presented the information.

Upon conclusion of the presentation, (Rowan) Chairman Cohen expressed his thanks to the Site Designation Review Committee for their efforts in compiling the report, and recognized those members in attendance.

He then announced the August 17th meeting in Raleigh, N.C., at which time reports will be presented to the Hazardous Waste Management Commission from both Granville and Rowan/Iredell Committees. Chairman Cohen invited all citizens to attend the meeting.

(Rowan) Chairman Cohen also announced a Prayer Service to be held on the Jake Koontz farm on 8/26/90 at 7:00 p.m.

Both Boards then expressed their thanks to the Site Designation Review Committee and to the citizens for their support.

There being no further business, (Rowan) Vice-Chairman Swaim made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Knox seconded, with unanimous approval of both Boards.
