NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing in the J. Newton Cohen, Sr. Room on the second floor of the J. Newton Cohen, Sr. Rowan County Administration Building in Salisbury, North Carolina, on Monday, December 2, 2013 beginning at 3:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as may be heard on the following:

In accordance with North Carolina General Statute §158-7.1(c), the purpose of the hearing will be to receive public comments on a proposed Economic Development Incentive being considered for Shat-R-Shield, Inc., whose operations are located at 116 Ryan Patrick Dr, Salisbury, NC.

The Incentive offer consists of the donation of less than 12,000 cubic yards of "fill dirt," to be removed from county-owned property in accordance with NCGS §158-7.1. If the full donation of material is utilized, the estimated value is approximately \$25,000. The donated material would be utilized to improve the physical terrain at the Company's current location, in order to facilitate an expansion of their existing operations.

The project is expected to (1) create a significant investment in real estate and equipment, approaching \$1 million and (2) retain more than 60 jobs in Rowan County, while supporting additional job growth. The County will recover the cost and the public will benefit through future property and business taxes, stimulation of the economy, promotion of business and the creation of jobs in Rowan County.

All persons interested in this Incentive are invited to attend this public hearing and present their views.
