Friday, May 28

Arrive at Monticello, the home which Thomas Jefferson designed and which has been called "one of eight places every American should see." Enjoy lunch at Monticello before touring the home and the newly opened visitor's center. Travel to our motel, the English Inn, to freshen up before dinner on your own (Dutch treat) on the charming pedestrian mall in Charlottesville.

Saturday, May 29

Enjoy the breakfast buffet at the English Inn before going to Ash Lawn-Highland, home of James Monroe and an historic house museum and working farm. Travel to Orange for lunch (Dutch treat) and then visit Montpelier, home of James and Dolley Madison, which has recently been extensively restored to greater historical accuracy. After the tour of Montpelier and time to explore, enjoy dinner at the Bavarian Chef in Madison, noted for outstanding German food near Virginia's Blue Ridge.

Sunday, May 30

After breakfast, leave Charlottesville and relax during a scenic drive to Wytheville, VA. Arrive at the Wohlfahrt Dinner Theatre and partake of a buffet lunch at 1:00, followed by a performance of the musical that plays homage to 1950s high school life: *Grease*. The staff of the theatre invite you to "sing along with one of the most popular musicals of all time & see why *Grease* is still the word!"

Return to Salisbury in the early evening.
