This year the Rufty-Holmes Senior Center will sponsor PROJECT FAN – HEAT RELIEF. The Center has received a generous allocation of regional funds from Duke Energy, enabling Rufty-Holmes to purchase fans for seniors who may have health risks associated with the intense heat of summer.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- The person receiving the fan must be at least 60 years of age.
- He or she must be a resident of Rowan County.
- The senior must have a discernible need for a fan, such as having no air conditioning, or needing supplemental movement of air.
- The senior should not have received a fan through this program the previous year.
- Eligible seniors may call to reserve a fan which can be picked up at the Rufty-Holmes Senior Center. Please be prepared to share the name, address, phone number, age, and date of birth, for the person receiving the fan.

The SUMMER FAN PROGRAM runs from June through August.
