

Rowan County Weatherization Program

Weatherization services are available to qualified Rowan County residents through a partnership between the Salisbury-Rowan Community Action Agency and Yadkin Valley Economic Development District.

Weatherization is a free program to increase the energy efficiency and safety of homes of elderly, disabled and low-income families. Its can include weather-stripping, air infiltration reduction, attic insulation, floor insulation, wall insulation, water heater insulations, pipe insulation, water conservation and other energy-saving measures.

Yadkin Valley district staff will provide the services to Rowan County residents and meet with applicants at the Community Action Agency's Salisbury office, 1300 W. Bank St. Weatherization services are also available for site-built houses and manufactured housing.

To qualify for the weatherization program, a household must have had a gross income for the past 12 months that is less than 200 percent for the household size based on 2018 federal poverty guidelines. For example, a family of four's income for the past year must be at least \$25,100 but not more than \$50,200.

Eligibility for services does not always mean there are resources available, however.
