Appointments and Fees

Appointments are necessary for most services. The cost of most services is based on your income. Medicaid, Medicare and certain insurance plans are accepted.

Family Health Services 704-216-8782

Family Health Services provides well and sick care for adults and children. Services are provided for those with Medicaid, certain insurance plans and self-pay.

Services include:

- * Physical exams
- * Kindergarten and school physicals
- * Annual women's health physicals
- * Breast and cervical cancer screening
- * Ingrown or infected toenail removal
- * Contraceptive methods and education
- * Tuberculosis testing and treatment
- * Sexually transmitted disease testing and treatment
- * HIV testing and counseling
- * Hepatitis C testing
- * Communicable disease follow-up and education
- * Narcan/Naloxone distribution

Dental Health Staff provide the following services:

- * Dental care in clinic setting for children through ~~10~~ 12 years of age.
- * Services are provided for those with Medicaid, certain insurance plans and self-pay.
- * Prenatal oral health program for RCHD Prenatal Patients



Care Management Services 704-216-8867

Care Managers provide the following programs:

- * Care Coordination for Children (CC4C)
Care Management for children birth to 5 years of age who are considered high risk
- * Pregnancy Care Management
Care Management for pregnant Medicaid recipients who are determined to be at risk for poor birth outcomes

Health Education 704-216-8795

Health Educators help individuals and communities adopt healthy lifestyles:

- * Community presentations on a variety of health-related topics
- * Promote and assist in creating policy and environmental changes that support healthy behaviors
- * Work with community stakeholders to create and manage sustainable programs geared towards improving health outcomes in target populations
- * Coordinate the Community Health Assessment (CHA) process
- * Create Community Health Action Plans (CHAPs) to address identified health-related issues
- * Publish the State of the County Health Report (SOTCH)

Immunizations 704-216-8786

Immunization Clinic provides the following vaccine services:

- * For children birth through age 18:
Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Chickenpox, Hepatitis A & B, Human Papilloma Virus (HPV), Meningitis
- * For adults:
Tetanus, Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella. Flu vaccine is available beginning each fall.

Children (WIC)

WIC is a nutrition program for women, infants and children.

WIC provides vouchers for the following *healthy foods at no cost*:

- * Milk/Cheese/Yogurt
- * Juice
- * Whole grain foods
- * Dried beans and peas
- * Infant formula
- * Eggs
- * Cereal
- * Peanut butter
- * Infant cereal/foods
- * Fruit & vegetables

WIC also provides *nutritional information on the following topics*:

- * Infant feeding
- * Breastfeeding
- * Nutrition for healthy pregnancy
- * Child growth and development
- * Special diets
- * Food buying

WIC also provides breastfeeding guidance, education and support.
