As Rowan County Public Health transitions from mass vaccinations, please know that our number one priority continues to be making sure our community gets vaccinated. As we move forward, we will now focus more on partnering with local businesses and areas throughout Rowan County where access may be an issue, in addition to making sure that all eligible youth get vaccinated as soon as possible. Please note that as of yesterday, the CDC now recommends that **all youth ages 12 years and older now get vaccinated with the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine**. By doing this, they are not only protecting themselves from COVID-19, but preventing virus-related hospitalizations and deaths.
