

CAMPGROUND RULES

1. Adults 21 years of age must register and occupy site. No group camping. 2 tents maximum on sites. Two night minimum on weekends. In the event of an unruly camper, Call 911.
2. Do not operate any unlicensed vehicles (golf carts, electric scooters etc.) or let an unlicensed driver operate any vehicle in park boundaries. Motorcyclists and children under 16 riding bikes or scooters need helmets. Fishermen 16 years or over need state license and all fisherman need armbands.
3. Alcohol and intoxicating substances are prohibited. Firearms and fire works are also prohibited. No swimming pools.
4. Domestic pets are allowed only on sites, not cabin areas. They must be on leash no more than 6 feet. They are not allowed in park buildings. Barking or AGGRESSIVE dogs will not be tolerated. Clean up after them please. There are no pets allowed in cabin area. Cabin campers need to read cabin rules.
5. Leave campsite in clean, neat condition. Please do not throw food out for animals. Campers must put all trash in the dumpster at the entrance to the campground and water down fire when you leave. We will clean it. Use designated fire ring for fires. Do not burn trash; we are trying to recycle ashes!! Please use the recycling containers for aluminum cans and #1 plastic drink bottles only located at the store and bathhouses. No chalk graffiti please.
6. Dumping gray water on the ground is prohibited. Use dump station at first bathhouse. No trenching, digging, cutting shrubs or trees. Do not move picnic tables to other sites. Check at Campground Store to rent shelter for group picnics. 6 campers maximum on sites. 3 vehicles maximum on sites.
7. Quiet hours are 10 p.m. until 8 a.m. Visitors must be out when gate is locked.
8. Check out time is 11 a.m. for campsites and cabins. Campers can check in when their site is unoccupied or after 3 p.m. Call the morning you are coming in to check.
9. Camp at your own risk. The Park, Park Staff, Park Commission and Rowan County are not responsible for any damage or injury caused by falling trees, falling limbs, or any act of nature or man.
10. No permanent sites. No chain saws.
