Adults 21 years of age or older must register and occupy cabin.

That person shall make sure all those in cabin are aware of rules.

5 people max. 8 max for picnic. Any more than 8, you must rent shelter

2 Night Minimum on Reservations on week ends

Rain Checks Will Be Issued If Campground Staff Is Notified

4 Days In Advance Of First Reservation date

YOU MUST CHECK IN BEFORE PARK CLOSES TO LEAVE DEPOSIT AND GET KEYS. PLEASE CHECK HOURS DURING THE WEEK

NOVEMBER – FEBRUARY WE CLOSE GATE AT 5:00 PM.

Office closes 10 minutes earlier

No Smoking is Allowed Inside Cabins, Including electronic smoking devices

No Candles allowed please.

No Pets Allowed, Inside or Outside, No Exceptions

No Alcoholic Beverages Allowed

\$50.00 Keys/Security/Damage Deposit Will Be taken (2 keys)

Upon Arrival (Cash, Check or Credit Card Authorization)

Deposit Will Be Returned After Inspection Completed and Keys Returned

Check In Time is 4:00 PM. (You may enter earlier if cabin is unoccupied) Call that morning to check if yours is vacant. Check Out Time is 2:00 PM,

Checking out late could result in deposit being forfeited

No Tents Allowed on these sites. Picnic Gazebos are O.K.
