This job description supersedes any prior description for the PT Airport Wildlife Officer classification.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Certified law enforcement officer with a high level of knowledge related to state wildlife issues and control of wildlife hazards. Semi-skilled work related to general maintenance of grounds. Work is performed under the supervision of the Airport and Transit Director.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS (Any one position may not include all of the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all tasks which may be found in positions of this class.)

Provide seasonal and on call wildlife control.

Assists with grounds and landscape maintenance.

Operates equipment such as tractor, mower, and plow.

OTHER JOB FUNCTIONS

Performs related duties as required.

Management reserves the right to add or amend duties at any time.

General knowledge of the methods, practices, tools and materials used in grounds maintenance work.

Ability to work independently.

Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing.

Ability to take direction work with other employees and the public in a courteous and cooperative manner.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Work in this class includes sitting, walking, bending, stooping, and lifting weights of approximately 65 lbs or less unassisted and weights over 65 lbs with assistance. Work will include outdoor activity where employee is exposed to elements of nature: cold, hot, rain, snow, sleet, ice, etc.

EXPOSURE CONTROL

Work activity does not entail predictable or unpredictable exposure to blood or body fluids.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

High school diploma or GED equivalency and North Carolina Wildlife Enforcement Officer Certification.
