

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing in the J. Newton Cohen, Sr. Room on the second floor of the J. Newton Cohen, Sr. Rowan County Administration Building in Salisbury, North Carolina, beginning at 3:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, on Monday, December 5, 2016 on the following:

In accordance with North Carolina General Statutes §158-7.1(c), the purpose of the hearing will be to receive public comments on a proposed **Economic Development Incentive** being considered for Boral Composites, a Corporation with operations in East Spencer and Salisbury, North Carolina.

The **Incentive** offer consists of an expansion assistance grant for a specific term of years not to exceed five (5) years, in accordance with NCGS §158-7.1. The subject properties are located at 500 Boundary Street, East Spencer, North Carolina, 28039 (also described as Rowan County Tax Parcel 024A003) and at 175 Circle M Drive, Salisbury, NC 28147 (also described as Rowan County Tax Parcel 471 059). The project is expected to create a significant investment in real estate and equipment, approximately \$5 million dollars. The County will recover the cost and the public will benefit through future property and business taxes, stimulation of the economy, promotion of business, the creation of new jobs, and the retention of jobs in Rowan County.

All persons interested in this **Incentive** are invited to attend this public hearing and present their views.
