

Dan Nicholas Park Autumn Jubilee Food Vendor Application

Currently the food vendor spaces for Autumn Jubilee are filled. Food vendor spacing is limited. Some of the spaces are reserved for local civic organizations for fundraising opportunities. We invite them back first, and try to use local vendors when we can. We try not to duplicate food items, and use exclusive sales of bottled sodas and water as revenue for Autumn Jubilee.

Occasionally we have food vendors decide not to return, and keep a list of applicants to choose from to fill the spaces. The standard space size is 20 ft. by 20 ft. for \$250. All for-profit food vendors are required to obtain and provide a NC Sales and Use Tax Certificate number and liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000. Rowan County health department and fire marshal will inspect your set up and equipment, and all requirements and codes must be met. 220v/50 amp hookups are limited and not usually available unless a vendor with that requirement drops out. Generators are not allowed.
