Rules and Guidelines

- 1) Contest is for middle and high school students, grades 6th-12th.
- 2) Entries must be done without any adult assistance.
- 3) Cover designs must represent an EXISTING book that you have read.
- 4) Cover designs must be original and portray the author's work in a new way. Designs that copy existing covers or use copyrighted characters and elements (such as Disney) will not be judged.
- 5) The book's title and author must be included in the design.
- 6) Use markers, crayons or pens when creating your design. Do not use pencils, stickers or any other attached decorations. Judges will consider what shows up best when copies of the winning covers are made.
- 7) Cover designs depicting inappropriate material will be eliminated.

Entries will be accepted at any library location between **September 21st-October 10th.**

Prizes will be awarded in two age groups: Middle School (11-13 yrs.) and High School (14-17 yrs.).
