HIJAB, a head scarf worn by Muslim women

SOMBRERO, a broad-brimmed hat with a tall crown worn in Mexico

BERET, a round brimless cap worn in Northern Spain, France, and other countries

FEZ, a felt cap with a flat top from the Eastern Mediterranean regions

BANDANA, a square or triangular cloth worn in many cultures as a head or neck covering

YARMULKE, a thin, rounded skullcap traditionally worn by Orthodox Jews

TURBAN, a long scarf wrapped around the head worn by many people in Muslim and Hindu nations

KUFI, a brimless, rounded cap often worn by African men

COWBOY HAT, a wide-brimmed hat with a tall crown worn by ranch workers in the Western United States, Canada, and Mexico

KOFIA, a brimless, cylindrical cap worn by men in East Africa

USHANKA, a fur hat with ear flaps from Russia
